XXV INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF PHYSIOLOGICAL SCIENCES

The XXV International Congress of Physiological Sciences will be held in Munich, West Germany, July 25-31, 1971. The Congress is sponsored by the International Union of Physiological Sciences (IUPS).

The general outline of the scientific program has been established by the Program Committee of the Congress. The program has been so designed as to allot approximately equal time to Free Communications and Special Lectures, which shall also include Congress Symposia.

Physiologists throughout Europe have agreed to organize about 30 Satellite Symposia which will be conducted under the auspices of the International Congress. Most of these symposia will be held a week after the Congress, but a few will also take place the preceding week. The topics of the satellite symposia, location and organizational detials will be included in the 1st Announcement of the Congress to be distributed in mid-September.
