I. ANNUAL CONFERENCES AND CONVENTIONS—NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL

1. Association meeting

3. XXIV International Congress of Physiological Sciences

In selecting topics for symposia it is expected that the Program Committee will give preference to subjects of a somewhat controversial nature, but of broad general interest, and not recently covered in an international symposium. For speakers, special considration should be given to promising young physiologist with active research programs as well as to older men of established reputation.

II. PROMOTION OF RESEARCH IN MEDICAL COLLEGES: A NEW SCHEME:

A new scheme launched by the Indian Council of Medical Research aims at enabling research workers to devote their time entirely to research for a limited period. According to this scheme, the selected research worker will be treated as having been seconded to the Research Cadre of the I.C.M.R. for the duration of the scheme which will normally be one year but may be extended for two years.
