Fifth International Congress on Pharmacology will be held in San Francisco, California during July 23-28, 1972. The theme of this Congress is "Pharmacology and the Future of Man." Its purpose is to promote the exchange and advancement of pharmacological knowledge, and the application of this knowledge to the health and well-being of man throughout the world.

The American Society for Pharmacology and Experimental Therapeutics is host for the Congress and responsible for its organization. The preceding congresses have been held in Stockholm, Sweden (1961), Prague, Czechoslovakia (1963), Sao Paulo, Brazil (1966), and Basel, Switzerland (1969). The first two congresses were held under the sponsorship of the Section on Pharmacology of the International Union of Physiological Sciences, and later congresses were held under the sponsorship of the International Union of Pharmacology, the creation of which gave independent international status to pharmacology.
